What: mountain eco-stay

Where: Phewa Lake, Pokhara, Nepal

When: opens January 2019

A short drive away from Nepal's Pokhara airport, this luxury eco-boutique resort has seen some obstacles since the first announcement about its opening in 2015. It has taken until this month for the long-awaited hotel to officially launch. Sustainability is the core mantra at The Pavilions Himalayas, which relies on solar energy and the harvesting of rainwater to create bio gas for use on-site. Biodegradable signature toiletries are incorporated into its offering. The resort is surrounded by farmland, forested hills and a mountain-fed river where each villa offers spectacular views of a tranquil setting with the Annapurna mountains in the background.
