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


THE PAVILIONS BALI

MAKE A SPLASH

Our team's favorite waterfalls

- **Suwat (Gianyar):** a short stroll through the bamboo forest will take you to this hidden gem featuring a natural pool complete with its own bamboo raft.
- **Tukad Cepung (Bangli):** follow the steep steps and you will be rewarded with Bali's most scenic waterfall, guarded by high cliffs.
- **Leke Leke (Tabanan):** take a nature walk to this tropical jungle fall amidst a calm and refreshing oasis.
- **Kanto Lampo (Gianyar):** scenic waterfall best explored in dry season, with water cascading down a tiered rock formation.
- **Aling Aling (Buleleng):** a collection of stunning waterfalls that are a true adventure's seekers heaven, with activities including natural slides and cliff jumping.





SUNRISE AT MOUNT BATUR

Mount Batur is an active volcano considered sacred by the Balinese people with its summit at 1717 m above the East coast of the island. For picture perfect panoramas we recommend the trek at sunrise; brace yourself for a steep ascent but be rewarded with incredible calderas views and the feeling of being on top of the world.



THE WILD EAST

Your day starts off with a visit to the mystic cave temple of Goa Lawah, populated by thousands of bats, before reaching Tenganan Village, home to Bali's indigenous people. The Bali Aga still follow a traditional rural lifestyle, unchanged by the passing of time and cherish their unique traditions and heritage.

After lunch, make your way to the water gardens of Tirta Gangga. The royal palace is a maze of pools and fountains surrounded by lush gardens filled with carvings and statues. Your way back to The Pavilions will take you through traditional snake fruit plantations and the terraced hills of the Sidemen valley.

UNDERWATER LOVE

Bali is an underwater paradise waiting to be explored for snorkelers and scuba divers of all levels, with an exceptionally rich marine life. Located at the heart of the Coral Triangle, the warm waters around the island are abundant with sharks, turtles and a kaleidoscopic range of tropical fish.

Blue Lagoon is perfect for snorkeling, with its own coral reef just off the small beach. **Amed & Tulamben** have a wealth of sites including coral gardens, wall dives and renown wreck diving. Experienced divers will enjoy spectacular sites with drop-off walls, drift diving and wildlife sightings around **Nusa Penida**.

BABI GULING

One of the island's most famous delicacies, Bali's take on spit-roasted pig, is stuffed with an aromatic spice mix known as 'base genep' and slow-roasted on an open fire until the skin is crispy and the meat tender. Originally prepared as a ceremonial offering to the Balinese Hindu gods, today it is a firm favorite for locals and visitors alike, served in warungs dedicated to this crackling specialty.

For a one of a kind cultural performance, head to the open amphitheater next to the temple to enjoy a traditional kecak, also known as fire dance, against the dramatic sunset backdrop.

End the evening with a "feet in the sand" Seafood BBQ on **Jimbaran beach**. The fishermen's catch of the day is grilled local style on coconut husks and served against the beautiful seashore backdrop.


HOLY HIKE OF THE EAST

After your hike, it's time to enjoy a Megibung lunch at Puri Karangasem, home to the Balinese royal family. This traditional communal feast, with a selection of shared dishes served on banana leaf, was originally reserved for ceremonies and special occasions.

PURIFICATION RITUAL AT TIRTA EMPUL



Tirta Empul is located in the hills of Tampaksiring, not far from Ubud. The temple is dedicated to Vishnu, the Hindu God of Water, and is considered one of the most sacred temples in Bali, with its waters believed to contain special powers of healing and blessing.

Originating from a number of underground springs, the water flows into a series of pools fed by fountains, each one dedicated to a specific purifying action.

Visitors are welcome to stroll through the ample complex or partake in the 'melukat' ritual, taking you through the different sacred pools clad in a special sarong for a unique soul cleansing and healing experience. Don't forget to pay respect with an offering to the gods and share a well-wishing prayer to complete your blessing ritual.

3 ONE OF A KIND MUSEUMS

1. **Museum Lukisan Sidik Jari:** located in Denpasar, this small museum showcases artwork made with a unique fingerprint painting technique, resulting in a creative take on French impressionism.
2. **Arma:** More than just a traditional museum, Arma is dedicated to the preservation and development of Balinese cultural heritage through events and workshops. The permanent collection ranges from traditional to contemporary, with exhibits by leading local and foreign artists who were inspired by the Island of the Gods.





3. **Museum Geopark Bali (UNESCO global network):** situated on the Southern slope of Mount Batur, it showcases a variety of information about the geological, biological, and cultural diversity of the volcanic landscape.



TRAIL OF THE ARTS

Start your day with a visit to **Tengenungan waterfall**, hidden in the jungles near Ubud. After a refreshing dip, make your way to **Sumampan Village**, Bali's original wood carving center. Visit some of the historic galleries and witness the craftsmen at work. Their unique carving skill has been handed down from generation to

generation, following a strict protocol and an unmatched love for detail.

Enjoy a local lunch in the proximity of Goa Gajah or visit Petulu, where every afternoon thousands of white herons, symbol of good luck and prosperity, circle over the rural village before settling into the trees for the night.

PENGLIPURAN

The cleanest village in the world

Penglipuran village is a beautiful highland village in the regency of Bangli in East Bali, best known for its well-preserved layout and culture. The architecture of the buildings follows the concept of 'Tri Hita Karana', the Balinese philosophy of balance between God, humans, and the environment. Manicured gardens line the single stone-paved street that runs

through the centre of the village towards the local temple. Age-old arched entrance gates conceal each traditional compound, laid out following Balinese spatial and architectural rules. You can also enjoy the trekking and mountain biking trails through the lush greenery of the nearby bamboo forest.



Don't miss: local souvenirs including Loleh Cemcem, a traditional natural refresher made from Cemcem leaves and produced only in this area.

Boreh is a traditional paste made from ground herbs and spices. This warming ritual begins with a Balinese massage, followed by a body mask & scrub and a harmonizing herbal bath, leaving your skin beautifully smooth and fresh.


To complete your day, visit the iconic Tegallalang rice terraces or plan a stop at the "secret village" on your way back.


CELEBRATIONS

LITTLE EXPLORERS

- **Bali Safari:** this extensive park houses more than 120 species from all over the world, including some of the world's rare and endangered animals, while also promoting wildlife conservation and animal welfare for future generations.
- **Ubud Monkey Forest:** A nature reserve and temple complex in central Ubud, home to the Balinese long-tailed macaque. Take a walk through the serene countryside but beware of the cheeky monkeys who are always on the lookout for food!
- **Turtle Conservation Center:** this facility acts as a rescue center and hatchery to support the rehabilitation and release of sea turtles in Bali. Visitors can get up close with the turtles, learn about their conservation efforts and adopt a baby turtle.



DISCOVER BALI'S VERDANT HEART

As you reach the lake district of Bedugul start by exploring Ulun Danu Beratan temple. The reflective surface of the surrounding lake creates a unique floating impression of the 8-tired pagoda temple, against the scenic mountain range backdrop. Rent a small motorboat for a fun tour of the lake as you cruise through the misty clouds.

With your dose of culture done for the day, it's time to explore the surrounding area, famous for its strawberries, which you can pick yourself directly from the field. Relax

with a fresh strawberry juice, a great way to cool off after a round of harvesting fruits under the sun.

Another highlight of Bedugul is the Bali Botanical Gardens; the vast park with its winding forest paths is the ideal location for an invigorating stroll or a leisurely picnic. Before returning home, stop at the traditional fresh market, where tropical fruits, spices, local snacks and handmade trinkets make for some great souvenirs.

For a once in a lifetime dining experience don't miss our Signature Seafood BBQ, with the freshest catch from the Flores Sea grilled tableside by your private Chef.



Only half an hour by fast boat from Sanur, Nusa Penida and its rugged beauty are the perfect destination for a daytrip, with more than enough to do, both above and underwater.

On land: Kelinking beach with its famous t-rex shaped cliff, the beautiful pool formation at **Angle's Billabong**, the natural stone arc at the adjoining **Broken beach** and the palm lined waters of **Crystal Bay**, perfect for some snorkeling. For local culture head to **Goa Giri Putri**, a Balinese Hindu temple set within a limestone cave, or explore the pristine **Diamond Beach**.

Under water: Both snorkeling and diving trips are popular on Penida with highlights including **Manta Point** – sightings (nearly) guaranteed, Mola Mola fishes at **Crystal Bay** (a bit more luck for divers required here), drift diving at **Toyapakeh** and stunning coral gardens at **Gamat Bay**.
