This celebration is dedicated to Dewi Saraswati, the Goddess of Knowledge, Learning, and Wisdom. On this day, offerings are made to books and manuscripts as an expression of gratitude for knowledge. The following morning, communities to gather at the beach for Melukat, a traditional purification ritual that cleanses both body and spirit.

PURNAMA (FULL MOON) September 7

During Purnama, the monthly holy day of the full moon, Balinese Hindus present ceremonial offerings in accordance with their local village traditions. Many temples also hold ceremonies or piodalan on this day, as it is considered an auspicious time for starting new ventures.
