PIODALAN AT TANAH LOT TEMPLE

December 3 – 6

Piodalan at Tanah Lot Temple marks the temple's anniversary, held every 210 days according to the Balinese Pawukon calendar. Celebrated with colorful offerings, prayers, traditional music, and devotional rituals, this ceremony transforms this iconic sea temple into a vibrant hub of spirituality. Visitors can witness centuries-old customs against the temple's dramatic coastal backdrop.

PURNAMA (FULL MOON)

December 4

During Purnama, the monthly holy day of the full moon, Balinese Hindus present ceremonial offerings in accordance with their local village traditions. Many temples also hold ceremonies on this day, as it is considered an auspicious time for starting new ventures.

DENPASAR FESTIVAL

December 20 – 23

The Denpasar Festival is one of Bali's biggest year-end cultural events, held in the heart of the island's capital city, featuring music and dance performances, street parades, culinary bazaars, art installations, and showcases from local communities. The celebration highlights Denpasar's dynamic fusion of heritage and modern culture, offering visitors an immersive journey through Bali's arts, food, and traditions.

PANDAWA BEACH FESTIVAL

December 25 – January 1

This Beach Festival is a lively cultural celebration held along the stunning white-sand coast of Pandawa Beach showcasing Bali's rich artistic traditions through dance performances, live music, theater, and vibrant cultural parades.
